

Warsaw Community Public Library takes the health and safety of our staff and patrons very seriously and we are closely monitoring the spread of COVID-19 in Indiana.

THINGS TO KNOW

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Please stay home if you are sick. The library is a shared public space, and it will take your cooperation to keep it safe for both staff and other library users.
- We have elevated our normal cleaning procedures thoroughly cleaning shared surfaces, and high traffic areas (such as doors, counters, and computers) daily.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the check-out desks (while it lasts). However, we urge the public to remember that hand washing (with soap and water for at least 20 seconds) is the single most effective thing you can do to prevent the spread of the virus.
- WCPL has no plans to close or alter hours or services at this time. If this changes, patrons will be notified via email, social media, and our website.
