National Library Week



Book Review: The Hush

I enjoyed *Hush* by Dylan Farrow. Her debut 2020 fantasy novel is found at WCPL as a YA audio book or a YA science fiction title. Heroine Shae lives in a fearful world where the "Blot", a disease which starts as a deepening blue in the veins kills all infected including her younger brother. The Bards of High House blame the ink in print words and images and even spoken stories. To survive, villagers turn away from "forbidden words, toxic tales, and deadly symbols". As a book lover I cannot fathom such an existence.



Only trained Bards, with the gift of Telling, can control the magic of language. They use it to silence the world. When Shae finds her mother murdered with a golden dagger, after her town is visited by Bards, who only use the weapon, she journeys to High House. Inadvertently she displays her budding Telling gift and stays to train as a Bard. This is the perfect cover to unlock the truth about her mother's death which seems to tie back to finding the Book of Days hidden in High House. A sequel is promised.






