

Fun Activities for Snowbound Kids




Warsaw Community Public Library can help you find things for your kids to do while they (and you) are stuck indoors. Our juvenile non-fiction section carries titles like “On Stage: Theater Games and Activities for Kids”. This revised edition contains more than 125 theater games that “spark creativity, boost confidence, and encourage collaboration.”

If you want to keep your kids’ learning muscles limber, how about “The American Revolution for Kids: A History with 21 Activities”, or its companion volumes about World War I, Albert Einstein, or Frederick Douglass? Electronic books are also available to download or stream to a device. Books from the series just mentioned are available on the topics of zoology and the civil rights movement in eBook form. Others are available on the topics of magic science and detective science.

Cookbooks are available; for example, try “The Math Chef” or “The Healthy Body Book”, with activities and recipes to do individually or as a group. You could try an audiobook. “Everyday Activities for Kids” is available as a CD, so kids can sing and be active.

Educational resources are available for parents in our department, as well. Look for titles such as “Astronomy Lab for Kids”, “150+ Screen-Free Activities for Kids”, and “101 Kids Activities That Are the Bestest, Funnest Ever!” Do it quickly. 



“I Know Who You Are”: a book review



Do you love mysteries? Does a cool cover pull you in? This happened to me with the book: *I Know Who You Are* by Alice Feeney. Unfortunately, my experience with this book was not a good one. I listened to it on audio through Libby, and was thoroughly traumatized.

We follow the actress Aimee Sinclair as she discovers that her husband is missing and her bank account is empty. Slowly the lies of her past come to the surface in an ever spiraling tale of woe.

I love a good mystery with a good twist. This one was a mystery, and it was twisty—but in my opinion in a terrible and traumatizing way. Not only is child abuse and sexual assault delved into in great detail, but the twist at the end just left me feeling sick. Some of you may now be tempted to discover what twist would do this, I would say you're better off not knowing. If your curiosity has been piqued, just read some spoilers or the last bit of the book if you're desperate. Don't waste your time otherwise. This is a book I will NOT be recommending. 




