CHANGES TO OVERDRIVE'S LIBBY APP

This March, Libby and OverDrive are rolling out changes for how they do holds. They will **NOT** automatically check them out to you once available. Here is how they will do it in their own words:

“Libby notifications will alert users when their holds become available. We will also add a “Notifications” section to your OverDrive website and the OverDrive app. After receiving notification that a hold is available, users can:

1. Borrow the title within 3 days. If your library has a different hold pick-up setting, OverDrive will automatically update it to 3 days.
2. Suspend the hold by selecting “deliver later.” This option passes the book to the next person in line while maintaining the user’s place on the wait list. After the suspension period (set by the user), the user will be able to borrow the book when the next copy is available.
3. Cancel the hold.”

We want you to be aware of these changes so that you pay attention to Libby/OverDrive notifications and snag your hold once they switch over in March. This new system should help people who don't have time for the book now, but might in 3 weeks. That way they can pass the book along and then be the next in line after the person they pass it to.

BOOK REVIEW: Sandhya Memon's *Of Curses and Kisses*

Did you fall in love with Sandhya Menon's *When Dimple Met Rishi* series? I know I did! Her authentic Indian-American characters and fun story lines have catapulted her into YA "rom-com" royalty as is evidenced by her numerous awards and bestselling novels.

If you haven't already heard, I am excited to announce that she has a new series out this year – and it is...wait for it... **FAIRY TALE RETELLINGS!** Yes, you heard me right! Menon is bringing her characteristic style and wit to the contemporary fairy tale retelling genre. Her first book in the series, *Of Curses and Kisses*, is a fantastic modern-day retelling of *Beauty and the Beast* set in a European boarding school in the Alps. The main characters are Jaya, a teenage member of Indian royalty, and Grey, a shunned British aristocrat who believes Jaya's family cursed him generations ago. Although their families want them to hate each other, they soon find out that they have more in common than they originally thought. Plus Jaya might be Grey's only hope to break her family's original curse. With just enough "is it or isn't it real" magic, this book will keep you wondering about the curse until the very end!

If you like fairy tale retellings like *Cinder*, *Ella Enchanted*, and *The Princess and the Fangirl*, you should definitely pick up *Of Curses and Kisses* by Sandya Menon. Highly recommended! — *Anna Jackson, YA Coordinator*






