

Getting started with the OverDrive app

You can use the free OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy digital titles from your library.

NOTE: The OverDrive app is available for Android™, Chromebook™, iOS® (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch), **Kindle Fire® tablets**, Kobo® tablets, NOOK® tablets, Windows® 8 and up, and Windows Phone®. OverDrive also has a desktop app for Windows and Mac®, which is covered in our "Getting started with OverDrive on a computer" guide.

Step 1

Install the OverDrive app from your device's app store or from <http://app.overdrive.com>.

Step 2

If prompted, sign into the OverDrive app. We suggest using the email address option.

Step 3

Find and save your library's OverDrive collection in the OverDrive app.

- Search by zip code (**46580**)
- Choose **Warsaw Community Public Library**
- Select **Indiana Digital Download Center**.

Step 4

Open the Indiana Digital Download Center, sign in, and borrow a title. You'll need a valid library card to complete this step.

Step 5

Borrowed titles will appear on your Checkouts page on the Indiana Digital Download Center. From here, you can:

- Download titles to your bookshelf in the OverDrive app – **choose the EPUB format**.
- Read, watch, or listen to titles right in your browser (without downloading them to the app – a live internet connection will be required)

Getting started with Kindle® eReaders

You can borrow Kindle Books from your library and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle eReader.

If you have a Kindle Fire, please use our “Getting started with the OverDrive app” guide.

NOTE: Kindle Books are currently available for U.S. libraries only.

STEP 1

Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to open your library's OverDrive website. Find it using <https://iddc.overdrive.com>



STEP 2

On your library's OverDrive website, use the search filters to find and borrow an eBook that's available in the **Kindle Book** format.

STEP 3

From your **Loans** page, select the **Kindle Book** format for your borrowed eBook. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

STEP 4

On Amazon's website, follow the on-screen prompts to “Get library book” and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle eReader. You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.



NOTE: Your Kindle eReader must have a Wi-Fi internet connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader via USB.

Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader, it works like any other Kindle Book.

OverDrive on a computer

Use these steps to borrow and enjoy digital titles from your library on your Windows® or Mac® computer.

NOTE: If you're using a Chromebook™ or Windows 8 and up, you can use the OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy digital titles from your library. See our "Getting started with the OverDrive app" guide for more help.

Step 1

Go to WCPL's OverDrive website: Indiana Digital Download Center (<http://iddc.lib.overdrive.com>).

Step 2

Sign in and use the search bar to locate and borrow a title. You'll need a valid library card to complete this step.

Step 3

Borrowed titles will appear on your Checkouts page on the Indiana Digital Download Center. From here, you can:

- Read, watch, or listen to titles right in your browser – a live internet connection is required.
- Download eBooks, then read them using free Adobe Digital Editions software or transfer them to supported eReaders
- Download audiobooks, then listen to them using OverDrive's free desktop app for Windows or Mac or transfer them to supported MP3 players
- Send Kindle Books to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app
