# Rules & Drawing Tickets

## Teen Summer Reading Program Rules

- You may log pages from books (including graphic novels) or audiobooks read between June 1 and July 31.
- You may also log minutes instead of pages (but log as pages). If you read/listen for 90 minutes, record it as 90 pages.
- E-formats of books and audiobooks are also acceptable. Please refer to the print copy for a page count or use minutes spent reading/listening. camping
- Participants must have a valid WCPL Resident or Non-Resident library card and at least 300 pages logged to win one of the Grand Prizes.
- Spin the Wheel : To play - 1) You must have a valid Resident, Non-Resident, or Student library card in your name. 2) You must have no overdue books, lost books, charges of any kind, or any flags on your card to be eligible. 3) You can spin only once each week. You cannot re-spin or trade your prizes. If you land on Lose A Turn, you forfeit your spin for the week but still earn drawing tickets.

## Grand Prize Drawing Tickets

- Drawing tickets can be assigned to prizes via the Beanstack app, online, or at the Reference Desk.
- **All tickets must be assigned by 11:59 pm on Wednesday, July 31.**
- Receive one virtual drawing ticket for each 300 pages/ minutes read through 15,000 pages.
